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After Care Instructions For Your Clean Carpet

Now that your carpet looks fabulous, it needs to dry. Listed below are a few things you need to do in order to dry your carpet as quickly as possible with little inconvenience. If you fail to follow these instructions, it may take your carpet up to **24 Hours** to dry!

BEWARE !!

A wet carpet can cause you to fall or slip... Dry your feet before walking on a slippery floor!

1. Increase ventilation in the home - If the weather permits, open the windows and doors throughout the house to allow cross ventilation.
2. Increase air movement - Turn on a ceiling or floor fan. The additional air flow will make for faster drying.
3. Raise the temperature on your thermostat - Warm air will absorb more moisture than cold air which allows more evaporation from the carpet. This method is ideal if you need to leave and prefer not to leave your windows and doors open. 72° - 75° is optimal.

In the event of inclement weather, drying will also take longer because the moisture does not evaporate from the carpet as quickly as it normally would. Follow the above steps to accelerate the process as much as possible.

Yes, you can walk on your carpet, just make sure your shoes are clean and use caution as you walk off your carpet onto a smooth surface floor.

If you follow these easy steps, your carpet should be dry within in 4 - 6 hours. If it isn't, please give us a call and we will help you resolve the problem.

Do not remove the plastic tabs or styro-foam blocks from underneath your furniture for 24 Hours. The Color of your furniture will bleed onto your damp carpet.

If your carpet has Scotchgard™ or any other protector applied, it will take considerably longer to dry. Try to use a fan in this room to accelerate drying time.
